# Introduction

- The discipline of production management represents the basic pillar of the formation and preparation of future managers.
- The basic task of production management is to develop (and then implement) such a **production program, which will be economically profitable and attractive for the market.**
- PM should ensure the **commercial and economic success** of the business unit.
- Production management is required to be able to anticipate the needs of customers, monitor the competitive situation on the market, analyze trends in scientific and technical development, and systematically project its results into **increasing the quality of production.**
- The decisive **content of production management in business entities** should consist of preparation of production strategy, creation of diversified production program, preparation of new and market-demanded products, quality development, management of main production and service activities, spatial and temporal organization of production processes, material flow logistics and post-production service customer services.
- Production management **should not solve problems about how to produce**, it is a matter of technicians and technologists, but **how to manage the production process**, and production system and ensure its effective development.
